ABOUT NDA

The NDA written examination, conducted by UPSC twice a year, is the first step towards joining the Indian Armed Forces. The exam consists of two papers held on the same day. Paper I – Mathematics (300 marks) tests a candidate's knowledge of algebra, geometry, trigonometry, calculus, statistics, and probability. Paper II – General Ability Test (600 marks) is divided into English (200 marks) and General Knowledge (400 marks), covering physics, chemistry, biology, history, geography, current affairs, and general science. The total duration of the exam is 5 hours, and it is conducted in offline mode with negative marking for wrong answers. Candidates who qualify the written exam proceed to the SSB Interview, which evaluates leadership, personality, and officer-like qualities.

ABOUT SSB

The Services Selection Board (SSB) Interview is a five-day process that assesses a candidate's personality, leadership qualities, and potential to become an officer. It includes psychological tests, group discussions, outdoor tasks, personal interviews, and a conference round. Unlike academic exams, the SSB focuses on Officer-Like Qualities (OLQs) such as confidence, teamwork, decision-making, communication skills, and responsibility. Candidates who clear the NDA written exam are called for the SSB, which carries 900 marks and is equally important for final selection.
